TARA as an "enabler", is instrumental in the creation of livelihood support systems, training and capacity building for the rural poor and marginalised communities. Implementation of the TARA Akshar+ Literacy and Numeracy programme is a systematic process, carefully designed to deliver significant results in minimum time, and at the lowest cost. A comprehensive package of learning tools, methods, and materials is delivered through proprietary software, customised books and learning aids, by a cadre of intensively trained managers, instructors, quality control supervisors and testing experts. TARA Akshar delivers a systematic and uniform pedagogic experience to learners at each rural centre, while empowering the centre instructor with mentoring tools and skills. The programme has been running successfully in the states of Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi/NCR, Madhya Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Rajasthan since 2007. The program's primary targets are women in rural India, so that they can break free from the cycle of poverty. The number of validated Tara Akshar graduates now exceeds 165,000. This programme has a tremendous reach of about 1.5 lakh women and still counting.
