The outreach of this campaign exceeded more than 11,000 where expert organisations like iFOREST, School of Water and Waste, India Water and individuals participated Portal, tweeted/posted/reposted and shared the ways to recycle plastic bottles, Implement inclusive Extended Producer Responsibility to strengthen infrastructure, factoring collection, transportation and processing costs with informal Waste workers as partners, consumption of recycled products and bringing public and civic authorities together to deliberate on the issue.
