



Creating Awareness on Apprenticeship and Livelihood Opportunities for Girls and Women

Development Alternatives (DA) under the Bridge to Livelihoods project funded by Disha project of United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and supported by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) organised a workshop for Vocational Training Center Staff of NGO partners of Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (Tata Power-DDL) on 5th January 2019, for creating awareness on apprenticeship and livelihood opportunities for girls and women in Delhi. During this workshop, capacities of the staff of vocational training were built on various processes involved in connecting girls and women with suitable livelihood opportunities. As a part of Bridge to Livelihoods project, DA with United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and National Skill Development Centre (NSDC) is working towards connecting 50,000 women and girls with apprenticeship and livelihoods opportunities in five states of India i.e. Delhi, Haryana, Karnataka, Maharashtra and Telangana.
