Entrepreneurship for Job Creation and Empowerment Background Note

Over 30,000 young women and men enter the labour market each day in India, and the economy generates employment for less than half of this workforce. In the race for jobs more than 80 per cent, especially those from marginalized and backward areas are left behind. Micro enterprises can play an instrumental role in this transition as they create local jobs in large numbers. Employing close to 40% of India's workforce, any impetus to this sector will have significant multiplier effects on economic resilience, and social well-being. Age-old constraints imposed by social norms and lack of access to support services prevent people for setting up entrepreneurial ventures. This is compounded due to the limited and costly access to enterprise information and services.

Promoting a culture of entrepreneurship in Bundelkhand

Development Alternatives has implemented initiatives to bridge the information gap, enhance access to support services, and develop an enabling ecosystem - to unleash entrepreneurship. These are aimed at creating local movements that are self-sustaining and are designed to:

- Nurture constructive communities through building safe spaces for women, youth labs, local selfgovernment as centres of influence.
- Unleash entrepreneurial energies through knowledge building, capacity building solutions, and access to technology, credit, and marketing support at the last mile
- Build a robust enterprise ecosystem through joint action with local policy stakeholders and market aggregators

In the last one year, Development Alternatives has reached out to over 10,000 youth and women with information and knowledge on enterprise development and nurtured 200 micro enterprises across Bundelkhand while reaching a network of 100 local stakeholders
