

More than 1500 Women Made Literate Under TARA Akshar+ Programme

ARA Akshar+ is an ICT based Adult Literacy Programme of the Development Alternatives Group, being run in more than 8 states and has made about 2 Lakh women functionally literate. It is an extremely successful and cost effective method enabling illiterate people to read, write and do simple arithmetic. Using advanced learning and memory techniques, and a sophisticated proprietary software platform, learners acquire sufficient skills to read newspapers, write a letter, and fill out Government forms.

TARA Akshar+ programme has been successfully concluded in Kachhuna Block of Hardoi District (Uttar Pradesh). Supported by the HCL Foundation, with the help of CSO partner Sarvodaya Ashram, a total of 1556 women have been made functionally literate in the six gram panchayats of the district within a time period of August 2017 and April 2019. The women have also undergone Gyan Chaupali training for the six months. A ceremony to mark the successful completion of the project was organised on 24th April 2019 in Subhash Chandra Bose Degree College, village Kahli, Block Kachhauna of Hardoi District. The TARA Akshar+ instructors, TARA Sahelis, supervisors, facilitators and senior supervisor were felicitated with certificates, acknowledging their efforts for positively impacting the community with literacy.
