TARA Akshar+ Programme

TARA Akshar+ is an ICT based programme which imparts functional literacy in Hindi and basic arithmetic in just 56 days. Gyan Chaupali is then established as a post-literacy programme for 6 months, which strengthens and builds upon the learnings, and provides effective information.

India has high illiteracy levels, particularly among women. Development Alternatives, under its mandate to empower communities, developed the TARA Akshar+ programme to impart functional literacy in rural and urban spaces. The focus is also on community development, along with imparting literacy to women.

TARA Akshar+ programme functions via a comprehensive software developed through stages of intensive grassroot level



research and study of best practices globally. Specially designed classes are conducted by locally trained instructors in the learners' own communities.

TARA Akshar+ sessions are topped up with Gyan Chaupali for reducing recidivism and enhancing the application part of literacy.

Over 2,00,000 women made functionally literate

Main Components

TARA Akshar+ programme starts with Akshar Gyan (Hindi) followed by TARA Ganit (Arithmetic); the overall sessions' time being of 2 months. The sessions for the learners start with Akshar Gyan and Ganit. The learners are taught to instantly recognise the sound of letters, syllables, numbers and form words and sentences using memory hooks embedded in animated movies and exercises.

Gyan Chaupali is the post literacy component of TARA Akshar+, that runs for 6 months. It comprises of awareness sessions on health and hygiene, financial & legal literacy and livelihood preparedness alongwith daily revision of Hindi reading, writing and arithmetic.

- At the end of TARA Akshar+ programme, the learners are able to read and write letters and simple three-letter words; recognise numbers till 100 and perform basic arithmetic.
- Enhanced participation and decision making power in the family and community.
- Participatory ecosystem, through overall community development contributes towards a cadre of enabled and aware labour force.
