Within three months of operation, he impressed the local community through his commitment to helping them acquire important documents and fill out forms for schemes and registrations. As a result, he eventually became a trusted and reliable resource for his community. He bridged the existing gap by providing internet facilities as well, which helped the community in having access to more opportunities. Even his father, who was sceptical at first about the loan repayment, is proud of his son's success now and stands by him as Balkishan attempts to expand his business.

Balkishan's CSC proved life-altering for him and his family and the individuals he employed and provided a steady source of income to. Balkishan's influence went far beyond his success and served as an inspiration to aspiring entrepreneurs.
